2022 Fox British Open

Event Sheet

Welcome to the 2022 Fox British Open. Please read the following information carefully regarding the rules of the event. All scoring will be done on the Fox Hollow Mobile App. If you do not have a handicap you will be playing at scratch. If you have a handicap and we don't know it, please tell us before the start of play. There is a Gross Division and a Net Division.

This is a shotgun start and you will play in the format of the hole you are on regardless of where you start or finish your round.

SCRAMBLE - Holes 1-6

Both players hit a tee ball, choose the best, and both hit from there, repeating the process until the ball is in the hole. You get one clublength (no closer to the hole) from the ball you choose, but you cannot move the ball from the rough to the fairway or out of a bunker or penalty area if you are unfortunate enough to have that be your best shot. Team handicap for this section is 40% of lower handicap player + 10% of higher handicap player. Since this is only for 6 holes, we use as handicap the number of strokes that each player would have received on the first 6 holes if playing their own ball. **RECORD THE SAME SCRAMBLE SCORE FOR BOTH TEAM PLAYERS ON THE APP!**

BEST BALL - Holes 7-12

Each player plays his own ball and records a score. The team score for that hole is the better of the 2. Handicap strokes are allotted to each player as they fall if he were playing a full 18 hole round. **RECORD THE GROSS SCORES FOR EACH PLAYER ON THE APP!**

ALTERNATE SHOT - Holes 13-18

Only one ball is played per team! You must decide ahead of time who will tee off on the odd holes (13,15,17) and who will tee off on the even holes (14,16,18). You then alternate until the ball is holed. Team handicap is the average number of strokes that the 2 players would receive on these 6 holes. RECORD THE SAME ALTERNATE SHOT SCORE FOR BOTH TEAM PLAYERS ON THE APP!

The course is set up with both tough pin positions and some unusual tee boxes, so please make sure you tee off from the correct box on each hole! You will be playing the BLUE TEES. The important ones to make note of are:



#4 – Tee off from the Red tee box on #3 #9 – Tee off from Red tee box on #8 #10 – Tee off from the Blue tee box on #1 #12—Tee off from right of #11 Green
