Gross score on holes 1 thru 6, net score on holes 7 thru 12, putts for holes 13 thru 18

A colored ball will be given to each team, each player must play this ball at least 4 times Low net score wins, keep score for the colored ball, pay out will be prorated on number of holes played with each ball.
If the ball is hit into the water, swamp or out of bound the ball is out of play
